All of the below individual coaches are International Coaching Federation (ICF) Level 1 or higher trained coaches who have training and experience in coaching pastors. All coaches provide services via secure online platforms.

Developmental coaching has been defined as partnering with clients in a thought-provoking and creative process that assists an individual in their personal and professional growth. It is not mentoring or clinical psychotherapy. The costs of coaching are typically \$100 - \$125 per session. Coaching is not covered by healthcare insurance, however, some Districts and churches may be open to sharing costs for their pastors.
