

Title VI Notice of Nondiscrimination

Trevecca Nazarene University complies with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. No person in the United States shall, on the basis of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any University program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

Title VI applies throughout the University's federally assisted programs and activities, including, as applicable, admissions, recruitment, financial aid, academic programs, student services, counseling and guidance, discipline, athletics, housing, and other University-administered programs.

Discrimination and retaliation against any person who raises a civil-rights concern, files a complaint, or participates in an investigation are prohibited.
