We value the approval of <u>Tennessee's State Board of Education</u> and our national accreditation through the <u>Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation</u> (<u>CAEP</u>) after an exceptional review conducted in the fall of 2022. Our next review will be in 2029. Trevecca Nazarene University educational licensure and endorsement programs are not approved by any other states for licensure recommendation. However, reciprocity may exist between state accrediting bodies**. Reciprocity agreements allow states to work through variations in licensing systems to coordinate license transfer.
